Events of Interest

Beginning January 1, 2007, Public Act 94 1009 states that when a driver of a motor vehicle receives a citation for a violation of the Illinois Vehicle Code and appears in court and receives court supervision that the defendant shall pay a \$20.00 fee. The fee will be given to the law enforcement agency and shall be used for the acquisition and maintenance of police vehicles. This is the first month we received a check from the Circuit Clerk's Office and it was for \$1,345.00. Each month's amount will be provided on the monthly report for your review.

Captain Nick Sikora, Officer John Wolfenbarger and Officer Pat Wicyk all received the Life Saving Award from the Kendall County Association of Chiefs of Police and the Oswego and Yorkville Optimist Clubs for their individual efforts that resulted in the saving of a human life. All 3 officers were involved in separate incidents throughout 2006.

On February 2, 2007, we facilitated a table top exercise to test our Emergency Operation Plan. The exercise took place at the Oswego High School with participants from several law enforcement agencies, fire districts, public officials, emergency dispatchers and school officials. The exercise provided all participants with an insight to a real scenario and they left with an understanding of each others responsibilities. We will plan a real time scenario sometime within the next year.

We started a new program with the Oswego Community School District this February called Facing All Choices Together, F.A.C.T. This will be taught to fifth graders within the Village of Oswego. This program is focused on bullying, alcohol and drug abuse. It is being taught by Oswego Police Department personnel. We will evaluate the program at the end of this school year and make a recommendation for the next school year. We are no longer teaching the D.A.R.E. curriculum.

Community Concerns

02/07 We received a concern from the HOA in Arbor Gate Subdivision regarding the traffic volume on Paradise Parkway. Their concern was regarding the possible need for a full 3-way stop control at the intersection of Paradise Parkway and Terrace Lane. A speed and traffic count was completed in that area that showed we are well below the vehicle counts needed for a full stop control. The 30 mph speed limit in the area is generally being followed as 85% of the motorists were traveling at 31.5 mph.

Continued Patrols:

- During the month of February we continued to provide extra patrols to the same 18 extra patrol locations as we did in January. February saw some reduced times and numbers of activities, most likely due to the harsh weather conditions we had. Officers spent more time dealing with weather related issues this month than the previous.
