### **Events of Interest**

Sergeant Dan Kipper began the Northwestern University Staff and Command Course. He will be completing 400 hours of training, which is done in two-week block increments so that he may rotate between the school at the Plainfield Police Department and working at the Oswego Police Department. He is scheduled to graduate on May 16, 2008.

All sworn officers participated in the Defensive Tactics training this month for knife defense. The training is two hours long and focuses on edged weapons defense and survival.

We partnered with the Oswego Community Unit School District and applied for a grant to teach Too Good for Drugs program to students. The grant is for three years and each year the program could receive between \$250,000.00 and \$400,000.00. I will update the Board when we receive word on our application.
