Events of Interest

Sergeant Dan Kipper began the Northwestern University Staff and Command Course. He will be completing 400 hours of training, which is done in two-week block increments so that he may rotate between the school at the Plainfield Police Department and working at the Oswego Police Department. He is scheduled to graduate on May 16, 2008.

All sworn officers participated in the "Red Man" Defensive Tactics training this month for self-defense. The training is two and one half hours long and focuses on control tactics, handcuffing, and identifying possible weapons in scenario type training for self-defense and survival.

Officer Chad Vargas will be receiving his DUI Enforcement pin from IDOT as he has surpassed the 25 DUI arrest mark to gain his first recognition pin from IDOT.
