### **Law of Interest**

With the summer road construction season in full swing now, we felt it appropriate to address the issue of construction speed zones. Construction speed zones (areas under repair that have been posted with a lower speed limit than is normally posted on that road) are covered under 625 ILCS 5/11-605. Subsection (b) states: "No person shall operate a motor vehicle in a construction or maintenance zone at a speed in excess of the posted speed limit when workers are present and so close to the moving traffic that a potential hazard exists because of motorized traffic."

Subsection (d) further states: "Highway construction or maintenance zone special speed limit signs shall be of a design approved by the Department. The signs shall give proper due warning that a construction or maintenance zone is being approached and shall indicate the maximum speed limit in effect. The signs shall also state the amount of the minimum fine for a violation when workers are present."

### Community Concerns

06/30 A concern about speeding vehicles on Heritage Drive was received. Three hours and five minutes of extra patrol were provided in this area since June 30<sup>th</sup> in response to the concern; one citation for speeding was issued. A speed study was completed and found the 85<sup>th</sup> percentile speed was 28.6mph. We will continue extra patrols in the area in August, but it does not appear that there is a significant disregard for the posted 25mph speed limit in this area.

07/09 A concern of speeding motorists in the area of Charlotte and Wembley was received. The area will be scheduled for a speed study.

07/28 A concern came in regarding speeding vehicles on North Adams Street near the bike trail. This area will be monitored in August and a speed study completed.

07/31 A speeding concern was received for the area of Arboretum Way; 15 minutes of extra patrol was done on the 31<sup>st</sup> and resulted in one warning being issued.

Continuing Extra Patrols

During the month of July we provided 23 hours and 55 minutes of dedicated extra patrol in 16 separate areas that resulted in 8 citations and 33 warnings for various offenses.
