Events of Interest

PrairieFest went well again this year. The weekend was successful, a few small confrontations, but no major issues associated to the festival.

In June we kicked off our Citizen Assisted Radar Monitoring Program. Alumni from the Oswego Citizens Police Academy who have received additional training in the use of traffic radar are eligible to participate in this new program. These members go out to identified locations and utilize hand held radar units to monitor motorist speeds. Five total details were completed in June by these volunteers. These led to the mailing of several "informational" letters to vehicle owners, whose license plates were recorded and vehicle descriptions confirmed, who were observed in excess of the posted speed limits by these volunteers. These voluntary details ranged in time from one to two hours each, with two alumni assigned to each detail.

Officer Jason Bastin was nominated to the Mothers Against Drunk Drivers (MADD) for their Law Enforcement Award. Jason has made 50 DUI arrests since being hired in June of 2005. Additionally, he has been an instructor for DUI procedures in the Criminal Justice Program taught at both high schools.

Officer Lawrence completed both the Truck Enforcement and Scale/Weight Officer training classes to become a Certified Truck Enforcement Officer.
