### **Events of Interest**

PrairieFest went well again this year. The weekend was successful with no major issues associated to the festival.

Sergeant Brad Delphey and Officer Pat Wicyk were selected to the ILEAS Region 3 Mobile Field Force Team. These officers were selected to be part of this new team that is available to assist in situations involving civil unrest situations. They will be equipped and trained by ILEAS and the team is based out of the Plainfield Police Department. Equipment and initial training should be completed by the end of this calendar year making the team available for call out assistance in early 2008.

We graduated two Police Summer Camp classes for 2007. We had a total of 38 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders attend the week long class. The summer camp is designed to provide children with hands on police operations and instruction. The summer camp is sponsored by the Oswegoland Optimist Club and the Village.

Captain Jensen graduated from the F.B.I. National Academy. The F.B.I. National Academy is a ten week leadership and management school. The school is in Quantico, Virginia and has class participants from all 50 states and several foreign countries; in all 300 students were in Captain Jensen's class.
