Events of Interest

During the month of May we participated in the Memorial Day weekend (extended) Illinois "Click-It or Ticket" campaign for safety belt enforcement. We also had additional officers working hire-back hours for traffic enforcement under an IMAGE Grant from the State of Illinois. These are the same type of details we had in the same period last year.

IDOT provided the Village with two "Click It or Ticket" signs as part of this Statewide campaign. The signs given to Oswego were placed on Route 34 near Osage Court and Route 34 west of Route 30.

We would like to send our thanks to the Oswego Community Bank, Oswego High School, and Oswego East High School for the use of their marquees during the Memorial Day weekend to remind motorists to "Buckle Up."

Law of Interest

This time of year, especially with the warmer weather, we receive more and more complaints about cars playing loud music. While this is annoying to most, it is especially dangerous to the violator because they may not hear emergency sirens approaching. The Oswego Police Department, with its goal of educating the motoring public, will continue to aggressively pursue this type of violation.

The following traffic law can be found in the Illinois Vehicle Code 625 ILCS 5/12-611 titled, Sound Amplification Systems. The law is written as follows: "No driver of any motor vehicle within this State shall operate or permit operation of any sound amplification system which can be heard outside the vehicle from 75 or more feet when the vehicle is being operated upon a highway, unless such system is being operated to request assistance or warn of a hazardous situation. This section does not apply to authorized emergency vehicles."

Community Concerns

05/03/07 We received a call regarding vehicles disobeying the stop signs on Kensington Drive and 5th Street. 50 minutes of extra patrol time was documented with no violations observed, we will continue to monitor this area next month as well.

05/07/07 We received a call regarding the possibility of adding stop controls to the four-way uncontrolled intersection of Chestnut and Buckskin. The site was reviewed and a recommendation to the Public Safety Committee was made to add stop signs for east and westbound traffic at this intersection.

05/08/07 We received a call regarding adding stop signs at the intersection of Willowood Drive and Arbor Lane for traffic on Willowood. The area was reviewed and measured for possible distance/sightline issues related to the curve in the road west of this intersection. Those measurements and general area data were reviewed with the Village's Engineer and it was decided that as this is a "T" intersection that requires traffic on Willowood to stop or yield to through traffic on Arbor Lane, it was not recommended for any changes. The posted speed limit and distances from the curve to the intersection with no sightline obstructions did not warrant any changes.

05/08/07 We received a request for a handicap child sign to be reviewed for installation on Bluegrass Parkway. Appropriate information has been received and forwarded for approval.

05/09/07 During an officer contact in Gates Creek, several residents complained of vehicles speeding on Willowood near Bayberry. We completed one hour of extra patrol in that area and had no violations observed.

05/14/07 A complaint of speeding vehicles in the area of Secretariat north of Wolf was received. This area was added to the extra patrol list; it received 30 minutes of extra patrol with no violations observed and will remain on extra patrol log in June.

Continued Extra Patrols

In 13 additional continued extra patrol areas, officers dedicated 23 hours and 30 minutes of time which resulted in 27 written warnings and 22 citations for various offenses in those areas. These results do not include any of the new areas added that are listed above.
