Events of Interest

Officers participated in a total of 88½ hours of “Image Grant” extra enforcement in the month of November, which resulted in 207 traffic stops. Officers issued a total of 171 citations and 3 written warnings during these stops.

Traffic unit and patrol officers conducted extra details this month for crosswalk enforcement in the downtown area. These details resulted in a combined total of three citations and one written warning for failure to yield to a pedestrian, one speeding citation, eight written warnings for speeding and one other written warning.

Community Concerns

There were no new traffic concerns communicated to us during this month.

Continuing traffic concerns

- ❖ During the month of November, officers conducted 30 hours and 15 minutes of extra patrols in 18 separate locations listed for continued concerns. During this enforcement officers issued 16 tickets and 31 written warnings for various violations.

- ❖ Additionally, members of the traffic unit conducted six hours of extra patrol on North Adams Street due to continued complaints of disobeying the stop sign (at North Street), speeding and the results of our speed study. Our speed study indicated the 85 percentile speed of motorists was 35mph, which is over the 25mph posted speed limit in that area. Those six hours resulted in ten tickets and six warnings being issued for violations of speeding and disobeying a stop sign.
