### **Events of Interest**

The month of October was the month for Oswego Police Officers to participate in the bi-annual physical fitness standard test. Fifty (50) officers took the test and forty-one (41) passed. The physical fitness test is given to officers to provide them with a “benchmark” of their physical fitness level. Often these types of tests can be a “wake up” call to them. In addition, in 2003 when the residents of Oswego were surveyed, 95% of the respondents felt that Oswego Police Officers should pass an annual physical fitness test. A similar survey in 2006 revealed that 98% of the respondents felt we should complete a physical fitness test.

### **Law of Interest**

Effective January 1, 2008, the Illinois Smoke Free Act will go into effect. This act requires that all indoor public places be smoke free. Smoking areas can be established, but they must be located at least 15 feet from any entrance and no smoking can occur within that 15 feet area. There are some limited exemptions and they are listed at [www.smoke-free.illinois.gov](http://www.smoke-free.illinois.gov). If a person smokes in a prohibited area they shall be fined not less than \$100.00 and not more than \$250.00. If a person owns, operates, or otherwise controls a prohibited area and allows a person to smoke then they can be fined not less than \$250.00 for the first offense and up to \$2,500.00 for additional violations within the one year of the first violation.
