Law of Interest

Summer vacation has come and gone and we are well into the 2007-2008 school year. Before the school year gets away from us, we would like to take this opportunity to refresh you on the legal requirements for approaching, overtaking and passing a stopped school bus.

The Illinois Vehicle Code states that every driver of a motor vehicle shall stop their vehicle before meeting or overtaking, from either direction, any school bus stopped at any location for the purpose of picking up and dropping off children. The driver must stop before reaching a school bus that is displaying visual signals. The visual signals are 8 flashing red signal lamps and a red stop signal arm. The driver shall not proceed forward until the school bus is in motion, the school bus driver signals the driver to move forward or the visual signals are no longer activated.

If a driver of a motor vehicle is on a highway having 4 or more lanes, which allows at least 2 lanes of traffic to travel in opposite directions (i.e. Chicago Road/Route 34), that driver is not required to stop their vehicle upon meeting a stopped school bus **if** the school bus is traveling in the opposite direction of the driver.

Penalties for a driver that is convicted of violating this law will result in a 3 month suspension of their drivers license for the first offense and a 1 year suspension, if convicted of a second or subsequent violation within a 5 year period. In addition to the suspension, any person convicted shall be subject to a mandatory fine of \$150, or upon a second or subsequent violation shall be subject to a mandatory fine of \$500.

Also, as the winter months approach and the first snowflakes will soon fall, it is important that you clear your windshield of any snow, ice or frost prior to entering the roadway. The Illinois Vehicle Code requires that every vehicle, with the exception of motorcycles, are required to be equipped with windshield wipers, for the purpose of

cleaning rain, snow, moisture or other obstructions from the windshield. No driver shall operate a motor vehicle with snow, ice, moisture, or other material on any of the windows or mirrors, which obstructs the driver's clear view of the roadway. By keeping your windshield clear of obstructions, your visibility is increased, which improves your reaction time and makes for a safer environment on the roadway.

Community Concerns

09/04/07 A concern was received about speeding vehicles on Wilmette and Calumet associated with people attempting to avoid the wait at the traffic signal at Route 71 & Plainfield Road; the area was added to the extra patrol log.

09/08/07 A concern about motorists speeding on Linden Drive was received; the area was added to the extra patrol log. A speed study was conducted using the SMART trailer and showed the 85th percentile speed in that area is 25.2mph which indicates a good compliance level for the posted 25mph speed limit.

09/12/07 A concern about speeding vehicles on Blue Ridge in the area of Half Moon Court was received; the area was added to the extra patrol log.

09/19/07 A concern was received about speeding vehicles and motorists squealing their tires on Fayette Drive; the area was added to the extra patrol log. The complainant related it appeared to be mostly OEHS students trying to avoid the long delays on W/B Wolf's Crossing Road that are now going through the Churchill Club Subdivision to get to Douglas Road. The complainant also related similar problems during the "evening rush hour" times.

09/25/07 A concern about the speed of vehicles on the un-posted section of Harvey Road north of Wolf's Crossing Road was presented. A 24-hour traffic study was conducted which showed the 85th percentile speed in this area is currently 52.9mph. As we believe this speed is too high for the changed area of this road, we have presented this information to Smith Engineering to review and are investigating how to change this area to a lower posted speed limit.

Continued Extra Patrol Results

- ❖ During the month of September we had twenty (20) areas of continued extra patrols in the Village.
- ❖ In the 20 extra patrol areas this month we completed 44 hours and 55 minutes of documented extra patrol, which resulted in 31 tickets and 31 written warnings being issued for various violations.
