 Suspect Vehicle: Newer Model Black Crossover (car/SUV)
 Suspect Description: M/B unknown age possible 20-40, 6', average build, short black hair; dark complexion, wears jeans and t-shirts

Information Received: Between 09-06-08 and 09-09-08 an Oswego resident had numerous store credit cards opened in his name and used at area stores. These stores are Home Depot in Oswego, Aurora, Shorewood; Kohl's in Oswego; Dick's unknown location; Menard's in Montgomery and Plainfield; JC Penny in Montgomery; and Carson's in Naperville. The M/B suspect presented the fraudulent cards and some form of identification to the store clerks. Thousands of dollars worth of home goods were purchased to include: Dewalt tools, Maytag washer/dryer, flooring and bathroom remodeling supplies. Three people were seen with our suspect: F/B average build, long hair pulled back into a "bun", a F/B, thin build with long hair pulled back and a M/B, thin build wearing a t-shirt and jeans.
