



The footings around the Sally Port, Jail, Evidence and Employee entrance were completed. Wagner will be working their way around the front of the building toward the community room. As they approach the mechanical and elevator areas, they will be paying careful attention to the water table and moisture in the soil. Gilbane will be working closely with Rubino to verify soil and footing strengths. Our hope is that minimal undercutting of the soil will have to be completed.
