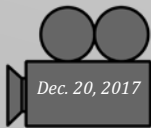
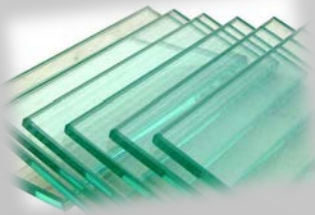

The curtain wall is made up of individual panes of glass each weighing 240 lbs. The installation device used to carry each pane of glass from the ground to the second floor has four motorized suction cups which hold the glass in place.

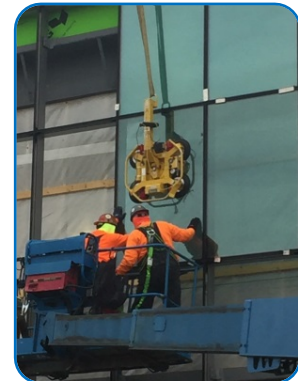
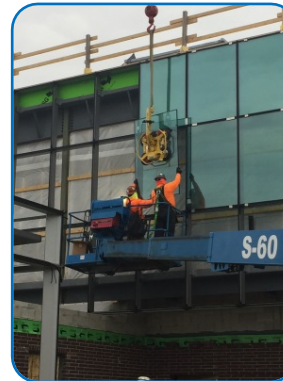
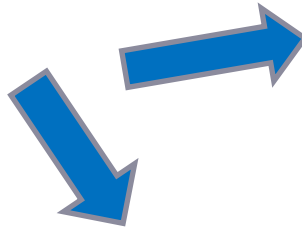
