The Plan Moving Forward

S & K Excavating and Mt. Carmel have been dodging the rain drops trying to get the earth prepped and dry. The building pad (where the building will sit) has been prepped with one layer of stabilization lime. With a few more dry days, we will be able to finish this portion of the work and move on to footings and foundation.

Next week, the plan is to lay down two more layers of lime stabilization and clay fill, roll the pad and prepare for the final layers of clay fill. S & K have been mining clay from our borrow pit which is a LOT of work. The pictures describe why we are liming the earth and bringing the building up so high.
