The storm sewer line is set to begin the week of June 12th. We are waiting final permitting from the IEPA. S & K Excavating has started adding dirt to the sewer line location to bring the ground to subgrade for Com-Ed. Electrical sleeves were trenched and completed so that Com-Ed can run the power lines underground along the front of the building




Lake Oswego??
