**WHEREAS**, the Village of Oswego diligently provides enhanced police protection to ensure the safety of all residents of the community during this annual holiday celebration; and


**WHEREAS**, the Village of Oswego has traditionally set trick-or-treat hours for October 31<sup>st</sup>; and


